1. RANGE LOCATION: The Ben Avery (Black Canyon) Shooting Range, 25 miles North of Phoenix, AZ. 1/2 mile West of I-17 on the Carefree Hwy.(Exit 223). Competitors will enter through the gate behind the 1000 yard line, this gate is 1/2 mile West of the main gate.

There will be a combination padlock on the 1000 yard gate. The combination is 2005. This gate must be kept locked at all times. If you come through the gate and it is open, lock it. If the gate is open when you come through it, lock it.

2. FACILITIES: **THE SLEEP INN PHOENIX-NORTH HAS GIVEN US THE RATE OF \$60.00 PER NIGHT FOR 2 PEOPLE PER ROOM. THEY ARE HOLDING A LIMITED NUMBER OF ROOMS. WHEN YOU CALL TO MAKE YOUR RESERVATIONS ASK FOR THE ARIZONA STATE RIFLE AND PISTOL ASSOCIATION RATE. THE NUMBER IS (602) 504-1200**

A camping area with electricity, water and toilet facilities are available, during the matches, for competitors only. Soft drinks are available but, bring your own lunch.

WARNING: GLASS BOTTLES ARE NOT ALLOWED ANYWHERE ON THE RANGE! Possession of glass bottles can result in a fine of from forty to eighty dollars.

3. RULES: Current NRA High Power Rifle Rules will apply. Competitors firing rifles conforming to rules 3.1, 3.1.1 & 3.1.2 will be eligible for the State Championship. Competitors wishing to use the NRA Match Rifle, rule 3.3 may do so but will only compete with other NRA Match Rifles.
4. ELIGIBILITY: All competitors must be paid up members of the ASR&PA. (\$20.00 for adults, \$5.00 for Juniors. If a competitor does not wish to join the ASR&PA he/she may pay a \$5.00 surcharge for this match).
5. ADVANCE ENTRIES ARE REQUIRED: All Individual entries must be paid in advance.
6. INDIVIDUAL ENTRIES: Make entry in individual on the enclosed Registration & Entry Form (NRA

membership number must be included). Entries MUST be accompanied by check, money order or NRA points. Make payable to: ASR&PA HP Div.. Mail to: Middleton Tompkins, P.O. Box 11684, Prescott, AZ 86304. Phone (928) 776-8576. Fees paid by those unable to attend will be refunded upon request, less a \$10.00 service fee, providing cancellation is made prior to 6:00 PM, Monday, 11 January 2010. There will be no refunds for those canceling after that time.

7. TEAM ENTRIES: Advance entries are not required. A team will consist of 4 firing members and must be from the same club or organization. State Association Teams may enter (Rule 2.12). A Team Captain must be designated. The Team Captain & Coach may be firing members.

8. ENTRIES CLOSE: Individual entries close 6:00 PM, Monday 11 January 2010. Entries RECEIVED after 6:00 PM, Monday, 11 January 2010 are considered late entries and may be accepted to fill vacancies on existing relays only, with a late entry fee of \$20.00.

9. ENTRY LIMITS: 180 Individual entries, 45 4-man teams.

Military competitors must make arrangements to pay all fees at the Match.

- Reminder: Everyone who is not a current paid up member of the ASR&PA must select one of the following options:
- a. Those wishing to be a member of the ASR&PA may do so by submitting appropriate fees (\$20.00 for adults; \$5.00 for juniors).
- OR
- b. Those not wishing to be a member of the ASR&PA must pay a \$5.00 one time membership fee for this match.

The Friday entry fee includes the 3 fired matches. The Saturday entry fee includes the 4 fired matches & the grand aggregate. NO TARGET SERVICE and all Range & NRA registration fees.

LATE ENTRY FEE: \$20.00 additional.

CHALLENGE FEE: \$1.00.

PRACTICE FIRING: The range will be open for practice on Thursday.

11. SQUADDING: All matches will be squadded. Squadding tickets for individual matches will be issued at the Stat. Office starting at approx. 7:00 AM on Friday 15 January, Saturday 16 January and Sunday 17 January. A competitor who fails to obtain his squadding ticket by 7:30 AM will only be squadded to fill up vacancies. NRA membership & Classification Cards must be shown before squadding tickets will be issued.

12. TARGETS: SR at 200 yds., SR-3 at 300 yds., MR-1 at 600 yds..

13. TARGET SERVICE: NO target pullers will be provided for Friday, Saturday or Sunday. Competitors will pull their own targets

14. EMPTY CHAMBER INDICATOR (ECI): An approved NRA empty chamber indicator is required to be in your rifle except during the preparation period the firing of your relay. Those not having an ECI may purchase one at the stat. office for \$1.00 each.

15. SCORING: Competitors will score. Any competitor failing to perform their scoring duties may be disqualified. The Fullbore scoring system will be used for safety reasons.

16. CLASSIFICATION: NRA High Power Classification will be used. Rule 19.6 "Assigned Classification" may be used. Those unclassified or without proof of classification, will be required to compete in the Master class. Please indicate classification on the registration & entry form.

17. DIVISION BY RIFLES: S Division, Service Rifle. M Division, NRA Match Rifle. A Division, Any Rifle.

18. CATEGORIES: Friday no categories. (Sat. & Sun.) Service, (Includes Reserve, and National Guard), Civilian Service Rifle, NRA Match Rifle.

19. AWARDS: Monetary awards will be given to each Match Winner and to the high individuals in each Category/Class award group on Saturday in accordance with a schedule which will be posted at the stat office prior to commencement of firing. Award groups must contain a minimum of 5 competitors or they will be combined with the next appropriate award group per policy. Second, third, fourth place, etc. awards will be given based on one award for each seven (7) competitors, i.e. second 8-14, third 15-21, etc.

SPECIAL INDIVIDUAL AWARDS: In match #8 a High Junior and a High Senior award will be given if there are 5 or more entries.

TEAM AWARDS: A Team Award and 4 individual awards to the winning team. To the high team in each

Class/Category - 4 individual awards. There must be at least 5 teams in an award group. If there are more than 6 teams in an award group, a 2nd place award will be given.

20. CHALLENGE PERIOD: The challenge period ends 1/2 hour after the posting of the match results.

MATCH SCHEDULE

Friday, 15 January 2010, 9:00 AM

MATCH 1a: 600 yds. slow fire prone, iron sights, unlimited sighters & 20 shots for record, 22 minutes. MR-1 target.

MATCH 2a: 600 yds. slow fire prone, iron sights, unlimited sighters & 20 shots for record, 22 minutes. MR-1 target.

MATCH 3a: 600 yds. slow fire prone, any sights, unlimited sighters & 20 shots for record, 22 minutes. MR-1 target.

Saturday, 16 January 2010, 8:30 AM

MATCH 1: 200 yds., slow fire standing, 2 sighters, 20 shots for record, 22 minutes. Rule 5.12 SR Target.

MATCH 2: 200 yds. rapid fire sitting, 2 sighters & 2 ten-shot strings, rapid fire, sitting or kneeling, 60 seconds per string. Rule 5.8 or 5.10 SR target.

MATCH 3: 300 yds. rapid fire prone, 2 sighters & 2 ten-shot strings, rapid fire, prone, 70 seconds per string. Rule 5.6 SR-3 target.

MATCH 4: 600 yds. slow fire prone, 2 sighters & 20 shots for record, 22 minutes. Rule 5.6 MR-1 target.

MATCH 5: THE ARIZONA STATE SERVICE RIFLE CHAMPIONSHIP. An aggregate of the scores fired in matches 1, 2, 3, 4.

Sunday, 17 January 2010, 8:00 AM

MATCH 6: 4-Man Team Match: The Presidents Match Course (no sighters).
10 shots, slow fire, 200 yds, standing, Team Time: 49 min.
10 shots, rapid fire, 300 yds, prone, 70 sec.
10 shots, slow fire, 600 yds, prone, Team Time: 49 min.

Approximately 11:00 AM on Sun. 17 January 2010

Match 7: Arizona State Championship (CMP) Service Rifle "LEG" Match starting at 200 yd range upon conclusion of Match 6. It is not necessary to enter the NRA Matches to fire this event.

1. OPEN TO: Any citizen of the United States 16 years of age or older.
2. RULES: This match is governed by the rules prescribed by the Civilian Marksmanship (CMP). (See CMP Competitions Rules & Programs).
3. ENTRY LIMITS: 180 competitors, priority to non-distinguished.
4. ENTRIES: ADVANCE ENTRIES ARE REQUIRED. Indicate on the enclosed registration entry form, and mail with appropriate fees to: Middleton Tompkins, P.O. Box 11684, Prescott, AZ 86304. You must complete the OFFICIAL entry, the CMP Entry & Score Card. This must be obtained from the stat office by 10:00 AM Sunday 17 January 2010.
5. ENTRY FEE: \$20.00. Include this fee with NRA Match fees. (\$10.00 CMP "LEG" entry fee, plus \$10.00 range and service fees.
6. ENTRIES CLOSE: Completed registration and entry form must be received by 6:00 PM, Monday, 11 January 2010 NBPRP Entry Cards must be obtained from the stat. office prior to 10:00 AM, Sunday 17 January 2010. After that time entries will be accepted to fill vacancies only.
7. AUTHORIZED ARMS: US Rifle Cal 30M1/M1NM; US Rifle Cal 7.62 M1/NM; US Rifle Cal 7.62 M14/M14NM; Rifle Cal 7.62mm M1A, having not less than 4 1/2 lb. trigger pull, with standard stock and sights as issued; or the US Rifle Cal 5.56mm M16 series or commercial equivalent, as prescribed for use in the National Matches.
8. AMMUNITION: NOTE: Competitors must now furnish their own safe ammo having the following characteristics. Ammunition may be commercially manufactured or handloads. Projectile will be a full metal jacket with a pointed tip. No flat tip or round nose. The projectile may have a "ballistic" hollow point such as that used in the current military M852 style, 168 grain, 7.62mm arsenal match round. These guidelines will apply to all authorized service rifle calibers, i.e., 7.62mm (.308), 5.56mm, and caliber .30(30-06). There will be no restrictions placed on bullet weight or muzzle velocity.
9. TARGET SERVICE: NO target service will be provided. Competitors will pull their own targets.
10. SCORING: Competitors will score. Last relay will score Relay 1; Relay 1 will score Relay 2, etc. Competitors not performing their scoring duties will be disqualified.
11. COURSE OF FIRE: The National Match Course (50 shots) No Sighters.
 - Stage 1: Slow fire, 200 yds, 10 shots standing. Time: 10 min. SR Target. The sling must be attached to the rifle but must not be used for support.
 - Stage 2: Rapid fire, 200 yds, 10 shots sitting or kneeling from standing. Time: 60 seconds. SR Target.
 - Stage 3: Rapid fire, 300 yds, 10 shots, prone from standing. Time: 70 seconds. SR-3 Target.

Stage 4: Slow fire, 600 yds, 20 shots, prone. Time: 20 minutes. MR-1
Target.

12. AWARDS: Credits toward Distinguished Designation and appropriate
Excellence-in-Competition badges, as provided in CMP Rules.
