1. RANGE LOCATION: The Ben Avery (Black Canyon) Shooting Range, 25 miles North of Phoenix, AZ. ½ mile West of I-17 on the Carefree Hwy.(Exit 223). Competitors will enter through the gate behind the 1000 yard line, this gate is ½ mile West of the main gate.

There will be a combination padlock on the 1000 yard gate. The combination is 2005. This gate must be kept locked at all times. If the gate is open when you come through it, lock it behind you.

2. FACILITIES:**THE SLEEP INN PHOENIX-NORTH HAS GIVEN US THE RATE OF \$60.00 PER NIGHT FOR 2 PEOPLE PER ROOM. THEY ARE HOLDING A LIMITED NUMBER OF ROOMS. WHEN YOU CALL TO MAKE YOUR RESERVATIONS ASK FOR THE ARIZONA STATE RIFLE AND PISTOL ASSOCIATION RATE. THE NUMBER IS (602) 504-1200**

A camping area with electricity, water and toilet facilities is available during the matches, for competitors only. Soft drinks are available, but bring your own lunch.

3. RULES: Current NRA High power Rifle Rules will apply.

4. ELIGIBILITY: Open to any individual.

5. ADVANCE ENTRIES ARE REQUIRED: All individual entries must be paid in advance

6. INDIVIDUAL ENTRIES: Make entry in individual events on the enclosed Registration & Entry Form (NRA membership number must be included). Entries MUST be accompanied by check, money order or NRA points. ***Make payable to: Berger Bullets***

Fees paid by those unable to attend will be refunded upon request, less a \$10.00 service fee, providing cancellation is made prior to 6:00 PM, Monday 1 February 2010. There will be no refunds for those canceling after that time.

7. ENTRIES CLOSE: Individual entries close 6:00 PM, Monday 1 February 2010. Entries RECEIVED after 6:00 PM, Monday 1 February 2010 are considered late entries and may be accepted to fill vacancies on existing relays only, with a late entry fee of \$20.00.

PRACTICE FIRING: There will be practice firing on Wednesday 3 February from 9:00AM to 1:00PM There will be a charge of \$10.00 for practice, please pay the range officer.

10. SQUADDING: All matches will be squadded. Squadding tickets for individual matches will be issued at the Stat. Office starting at approx. 7:30 AM each day. A competitor who fails to obtain his squadding ticket by 8:15 AM will only be squadded to fill up vacancies. NRA Classification Cards must be shown before squadding tickets will be issued.

11. TARGETS: LR at 800, 900, and 1000 yds. LRFC for F-Class at 800, 900, and 1000.

12. TARGET SERVICE: Target pullers will not be provided. Competitors will pull their own targets. There may be a limited number of target pullers available. The cost will be \$75.00 for the four days of individual shooting. If you desire a target puller, please enclose your \$75.00 with your entry fee and if a puller is available they will be assigned on a first come first serve basis. If none are available, your money will be refunded.

13. EMPTY CHAMBER INDICATOR (ECI): An approved NRA empty chamber indicator is required to be in your rifle except during the preparation period and the firing of your relay. Those not having an ECI may purchase one at the Stat. office for \$1.00 each.

14. SCORING: Competitors will score. Any competitor failing to perform their scoring duties may be disqualified.
15. CLASSIFICATION: NRA High Power Classification will be used. Rule 19.6 "Assigned Classification" may be used. Those unclassified or without proof of Classification, will be required to compete in the Master class. Please indicate classification on the registration & entry form.
16. DIVISION BY RIFLE: A: Any Rifle. P: Palma Rifle. S: Service Rifle. F: F-Class.
17. CATEGORIES: Service (Includes Reserve, and National Guard) & Civilian.
18. AWARDS: Monetary awards will be given to the Match Winner and to the high individuals in each Division Category/Class award group on Thursday, Friday, Saturday & Sunday, for Matches #1, 2, #3, #4, #6, #7, #8, #10, #11, and #12 in accordance with a schedule which will be posted at the stat office prior to commencement of firing. Berger bullets will be awarded to Match Winner and to the high individuals in each Division Category/Class award group on Thursday, Friday, Saturday & Sunday for Matches #5, #9, #13, #14, & #15. Award groups must contain a minimum of 5 competitors or they will be combined with the next appropriate award group per policy. Second, third, fourth place, etc. awards will be given based on one award for each seven (7) competitors, i.e. second 8-14, third 5-21, etc..

SPECIAL INDIVIDUAL AWARDS: In Match #15 a High Junior, High Woman, High Senior, and High Grand Senior will be given if there are 5 or more entries.

NOTE: An individual winning a place award (Winner, 2nd, or 3rd Open) shall be entitled to Special Awards for which he or she is qualified, but may not win a Category/Class award in the same match.

19. CHALLENGE PERIOD: The challenge period ends ½ hour after the posting of the match results.

MATCH 3: Palma Individual Match. Unlimited sighters and 15 shots for record 800 yds., time min. 2 sighters and 15 shots for record, 900 yds., time 22 min.. 2 sighters and 15 shots for record, 1000 yds., time 22 min..

MATCH 4: Palma rifle 2 man team match: 2 sighters and 20 shots for each shooter at 1000 yds. The match will be fired in 2 relays with 2 shooters per relay, time limit 47 minutes per relay.

MATCH 6: Any-rifle, Any-sight. Unlimited sighters, 20 shots for record, 1000 yds., total time 30 minutes.

MATCH 8: Any-rifle, Any-sight. Unlimited sighters, 20 shots for record, 1000 yds., total time 30 minutes.
