Eligibility:

- NRA Members and juniors who are members of an NRA affiliated club may compete. Foreign competitors who are members of their country's national governing body for Small bore shooting are eligible to compete.
- All competitors must be current members of the Arizona State Rifle & Pistol Association. (http://www.asrpa.com/html/join_asrpa.html) If you are not a current member, please include annual dues of \$20.00 for adults or \$5.00 for juniors.
- Out of state/country competitors may elect to pay a \$5.00 surcharge for this match in lieu of ASRPA membership.
- Non-Resident competitors are eligible for all awards including Arizona State Champion & Open Match Winner.

Rules:

- Current NRA Small bore Rifle Rules will govern this tournament.
- The rifle permitted is defined in rule 3.2.
- Competitors will hang their own targets and retrieve the adjacent target.
- Competitors will identify their targets and backers in the upper right hand corner of the front face of each sheet with their competitor number and the correct and complete match information.

Time: Firing will commence at 9:00 a.m. on Saturday, 8:30 on Sunday.

Squadding:

All matches will be squadded. Competitors in the same classification will be squadded together if possible.

Challenges:

A fee of \$3.00 will be charged for each challenge.

Course of Fire: The course of fire is a conventional prone 3200 as described below. Seniors may elect to enter a special Any-Sight 3200 Aggregate.

Any-Sight 1600 competitors are not eligible for State Champion awards or Open Winner awards.

Fees: Entry fees will be \$35.00 (junior \$20.00) for the 1600 aggregate.

Post Entries: Entries are limited to 35 competitors. Post entries will be accepted to range capacity only if an additional relay is not required.

Classification: The NRA Classification System will be used. If there are fewer than 3 competitors in a class, that class will be combined with the next higher class.

Awards: Plaques or trophies and certificates will be awarded to any eligible competitor. There are no cash awards.
