1. RANGE LOCATION: The Ben Avery (Black Canyon) Shooting Range, 25 mi. North of Phoenix AZ.. ½ mile West of I-17 on the Carefree Hwy. (Exit 223). Competitors will enter through the gate behind the 1000 yard line, this gate is ½ mile west of the main gate.

**There will be a combination padlock on the 1000 yard gate. The combination is 2005. This gate must be kept locked at all times. If you come through the gate and it is open, lock it. If the gate is open when you come through it, lock it.**

2. FACILITIES: **THE SLEEP INN PHOENIX-NORTH HAS GIVEN US THE RATE OF \$85.00 PER NIGHT 2 PEOPLE PER ROOM. THEY ARE HOLDING A LIMITED NUMBER OF ROOMS. WHEN YOU CALL TO MAKE YOUR RESERVATIONS ASK FOR THE ARIZONA STATE RIFLE AND PISTOL ASSOCIATION RATE. THE NUMBER IS (602) 504-1200**

A camping area with electricity, water and toilet facilities is available, during The matches, for competitors only. Soft drinks are available but, bring your own lunch.

**WARNING: GLASS BOTTLES ARE NOT ALLOWED ANYWHERE ON THE RANGE!**  
Possession of glass bottles can result in a fine of from forty to eighty dollars.

3. RULES: Current NRA High Power Rifle Rules shall apply.

4. ELIGIBILITY: Open to individual members of the NRA, except that Juniors may be members

of an NRA affiliated club in lieu of individual membership. All competitors must be paid up members of the ASR&PA. (\$20.00 for adults, \$5.00 for Juniors. If a competitor does not wish to join the ASR&PA he/she may pay a \$5.00 surcharge for this match).

5. ADVANCE ENTRIES ARE REQUIRED: All entries must be paid in advance.

6. INDIVIDUAL ENTRIES: Make entry in individual events on enclosed Registration & Entry form (include NRA Membership ID#). Entries MUST be accompanied by check, money order or NRA Points made payable to ASR&PA, HP Div.. Mail to Middleton Tompkins, P.O. Box 11684, Prescott, AZ 86304. Phone: (928) 776-8576. Fees paid by those unable to attend will be refunded upon request, less a \$10.00 service fee, providing cancellation is made prior to 6:00 PM, Monday, 2 February 2009. There will be no refunds for those canceling after that time.

7. ENTRIES CLOSE: 6:00 PM Monday, 2 February 2009. Entries after this time are considered late entries and may be accepted to fill vacancies on existing relays only. An additional \$20.00 will be charged for late entries.

8. ENTRY LIMITS: 100 Individual entries.

Military teams must make advance arrangements to pay match fees.

Reminder: Everyone who is not a current paid up member of the ASR&PA must select one of the

following options:

a. Those wishing to be a one year member of the ASR&PA may do so by submitting appropriate fees (\$20.00 for adults; \$5.00 for juniors).

OR

b. Those not wishing to be a one year member of the ASR&PA must pay a three day Membership fee of \$5.00 for this match.

LATE ENTRY FEE: \$20.00 in addition to appropriate match fee.

CHALLENGE FEE: \$1.00 The challenge fee must be paid at the time the challenge is requested.

PRACTICE FIRING: The range will be open for practice on Thursday, 5 February. The cost of this practice is \$10.00 and will be payable at the range. Firing will start at 9:00 AM.

10. TARGETS: LR at 800, 900 & 1000 yds.
  11. TARGET SERVICE: Competitors will pull their own targets.
  12. EMPTY CHAMBER INDICATOR (ECI): Approved NRA open bolt indicators are required to be used at all times except during the preparation time and firing of your relay. Those not having an ECI may purchase one at the stat. office for \$1.00 each.
  13. SQUADDING: All matches will be squadded. Squadding tickets for individual matches will be issued at the Stat. Office starting at approx. 7:30 AM on Friday 6 February, Saturday 7 February, and Sunday 8 February. A competitor who fails to obtain his squadding ticket by 8:30 AM will only be squadded to fill up vacancies. NRA membership & Classification Cards must be shown before squadding tickets will be issued.
  14. SCORING: Competitors will score. Any competitor failing to perform his scoring duties may be disqualified. The Fullbore scoring system will be used for safety reasons.
  15. CLASSIFICATION: NRA High Power Classification will be used. Rule 19.6 "Assigned Classification" may be used. Those unclassified or without proof of classification, will be required to compete in the Master class. Please indicate classification on the registration & entry form.
  16. DIVISION BY RIFLE: NRA Palma Rifle (Division P), Service Rifle (Division S), Any-Rifle (Division A), F-Class (Division F)  
NOTE: Individuals must fire the same rifle in all matches included in the Grand Aggregate.
  17. CATEGORIES: (Fri.) Service, (Includes Reserve, and National Guard), Civilian Service Rifle, and Palma Rifle. (Sat. & Sun.) Service, (Includes Reserve, and National Guard), Civilian Service Rifle, Palma Rifle and Any-Rifle.
  18. AWARDS: Monetary awards will be given to each Match Winner and to the high individuals in each Division Category/Class award group on Friday Saturday & Sunday in accordance with a schedule which will be posted at the stat office prior to commencement of firing. Award groups must contain a minimum of 5 competitors or they will be combined with the next appropriate award group per policy. Second, third, fourth place, etc. awards will be given based on one award for each seven (7) competitors, i.e. second 8-14, third 15-21, etc.
- SPECIAL INDIVIDUAL AWARDS: In matches #9 a High Junior and a High Senior award will be given if there are 5 or more entries in each division.
19. CHALLENGE PERIOD: The challenge period ends 1/2 hour after the posting of the match results.

MATCH 2: Any-rifle, Any-sight. Unlimited sighters, 20 shots for record, 1000 yds., total time 30 minutes.

MATCH 3: Any-rifle, Any-sight. Unlimited sighters, 20 shots for record, 1000 yds., total time 30 minutes.

MATCH 4: Any-rifle, Any-sight Championship: An aggregate of matches #2 & #3

MATCH 5: Any-rifle, Any-sight 4 man team match: 2 sighters and 20 shots for each shooter. The team match will be fired in 2 relays with 2 shooters per relay, time limit 47 minutes per relay.

MATCH 6: Any-rifle, Iron-sights. Unlimited sighters, 20 shots for record, 1000 yds., total time 30 minutes.

MATCH 7: Any-rifle, Iron-sights. Unlimited sighters, 20 shots for record, 1000 yds., total time 30 minutes.

MATCH 8: Any-rifle, Iron-sight Championship: An aggregate of matches #6 & #7

MATCH 9: THE ARIZONA STATE CHAMPIONSHIP- A aggregate of the scores fired in match #4 and match #8.
